



Ignite Transition Calf 10 AN



PROBLEM: Weaning is a very stressful period of a heifer's life. Young calves are expected to go from total dependency on a milk diet and milk stomach, to developing a true rumen with digestive bacteria, papillae, and volume that allows them to thrive on grain and forage. Not all calves can make this transition as quickly as the farm needs them to.

SOLUTION: Provide high quality feeds that meet nutritional needs of EACH calf. QLF Ignite Transition Calf 10 AN can be a valuable tool in a weaned calf feeding program.

FEATURES

- 10% Crude Protein (all natural)
- Provides supplemental calcium, phosphorus, trace minerals, and vitamins
- High levels of sugar attract calves to lick the tub.
- Target intake: 0.4 lb/day for 200-400 lb calves.

BENEFITS

- ✓ Sugars from molasses-based tubs enhance forage digestion, stimulate rumen bacterial growth, and aid development of the rumen wall.

- ✓ Tub consistency allows calves to lick easily but not overconsume. Stressed calves will consume higher amounts of tub; in doing so they receive additional nutrients/additives to aid growth, digestive function, and immunity.
- ✓ Provides a consistent and palatable feedstuff to ease the transition from pre-weaning to grower diets.

ON-FARM MANAGEMENT TIPS:

- Intake will vary based on calf size, nutritional needs, and stress level. Calves transitioning smoothly will eat smaller amounts of tubs than those experiencing stress. Typically, 200-400 lb calves will consume ~0.4 lb/day, with consumptions ranging from 0.1 lb/day for small or non-stressed calves, to 0.7 lb/day for larger calves or those experiencing high levels of stress.
- This product does not replace any pellets, grain, or forage in an existing calf development program. Ignite Transition Calf 10 AN is designed to complement existing feeds and provide a nutritional "boost" to calves during the transition period to grower diets.
- It is recommended to place tubs in the feedbunk (on, or off the ground), to prevent soiling of tubs. Tubs placed on the ground in pens may easily become soiled or stepped in by calves adjusting to new housing and management.
